Entry to BLS International Services Canada Inc., Indian Visa Application Centers (VAC):

- 1. Due to the limited size of VACs, attorneys (those accompanying applicants), relatives, drivers, or friends are not allowed in the VAC.
- 2. An applicant may however, bring one person to assist him/her if he or she is elderly, disabled, or a minor child.
- 3. Applicants should bear in mind that they may stand outside the facilities for their turn, please dress according to weather conditions on the day of your visit.

Important:

- 1. If you cannot visit the VAC, it is recommended that you use the postal service to submit your application.

- 3. Foreign visitors to Canada cannot apply for Indian visa services in Canada.

Online Application Form: - An Entry visa can be applied for 1year or 5 years only. - Application must be completed and submitted online. - Visit: http://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/ and select 'Online Visa Application Registration.' - Be sure to select the correct Indian mission based on the place where you reside in Canada, and the mission's jurisdiction. - Mission jurisdiction can be viewed at: http://www.blsindia-canada.com/entryvisa.php - After submission online, no changes can be made. In case of an error, please register afresh online.

Documents: Provide photocopies unless otherwise stated; attach the following valid documents in photocopies. - Provide copies for all the documents on LETTER size paper. - All photocopies have to be self-attested
Canadian Passport (Original): - Must be valid for at least 190 days. - Must have at least two blank/unstamped pages.
Additional documents for Non-Canadian Passport: - 'Additional Form to be filled by Foreign/Non-Canadian Nationals' – duly completed and signed. - Download at: http://www.blsindia-canada.com/entryvisa.php - Proof of Valid work status in Canada: Valid PR Card, Work Permit or Student Permit. - Proof of address in Canada: Driver's License, Bank Statement or Utility Bill (The latter two must be less than 6 months old).
Additional documents for Former Indian National Applying for a Visa: - Cancelled Indian passport - Landing Paper - Surrender of Indian Nationality certificate (if issued by an Indian Mission). - If your Landing Paper indicates/Family category, provide a letter from the Refugee Board CIC indicating that you have never applied for a refugee status in Canada
If Application is Based on Parent's legal Status in India: Documents of the parent with Copies: - If parents are Indian nationals: - Indian passports – both parents - Proof of work status in Canada – PR Card or Work Permit (The latter must be valid for at least 6 months) - If parents are of Indian origin: - Cancelled Indian passports and Landing Papers – both parents
