Part B may alternatively be printed in blank and filled by hand. After submission online, no changes can be made. In case of a mistake, please register online afresh. Long Term Visa/OCI/PIO- FC4 Category- applicant must provide landing paper to prove whom has sponsored the applicant. We can ask up to 3 generations. In case of death of spouse: Death Certificate issued by government authorities. Funeral Home Certificates are not acceptable. If un-married: Parents Record of Landing and Indian Passports. If parents are not Landed Immigrants or have never applied of Permanent Residence status in Canada, provide a self declaration. If divorced: Divorce certificate duly attested, and in English. BLS International Services Canada Inc. have no say on whether you will be granted a visa/passport/PIO card/OCI card, as this is entirely the prerogative of the High Commission of India, Canada. The Mission may also request for additional documentation at anytime during or after the submission of the application.

My documents are arranged in the order given above with the Checklist on top. I have been informed that any insufficiency in documentation as mentioned in the Checklist may lead to a delay/rejection in the processing of my application.

Although the OCI Card is a life long card, the Card and the Life Long Visa sticker that comes with it must be replaced <u>each time</u> a new passport is issued up to the completion of 20 years of age and <u>once</u> after completing 50 years of age. This is required as both these documents contain photo of the Card holder which needs to be renewed.
