Subsequently surrendered Indian passport but it has only stamp (as mentioned above) and no reference number on it. Subsequently availed visa from this Consulate and has copy of the same. With self-declaration can apply surrender of last held Indian passport with surrender fee but without retention penalty. (Declaration can be downloaded along with application form) It is being implemented with immediate/prospective effect and any surrender or retention fee already paid shall not be refunded/reimbursed.
