Entry to BLS International Services Canada Inc., Indian Visa Application Centers (VAC):

1. Due to the limited size of VACs, attorneys (those accompanying applicants), relatives, drivers, or friends are not allowed in the VAC.
2. No passport or consular services are available to claimants of refugee status in BLS Centers.
3. If you cannot visit the VAC, it is recommended that you use the postal service to submit your application. Alternatively, to book a pickup and/or drop via FedEx, visit <http://www.blscanada.com/vas/>

The Mission may also request for additional documentation at any time during or after the submission of the application.
